Remember James 5:17, prayer brings the power of God.

Isaiah 54:13 That they are taught of the Lord and continue to be. Proverbs 2:6 Father, give us counsel and wisdom in bringing up our children.

I Peter I:14-15 Pray they are obedient, not conforming to the things of the flesh, but holy, in all conduct.

I Thessalonians 4:I Pray that they grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord.

James 1:22 I thank you Lord that they are doers of the Word, and not hearers only.

2 Timothy 1:7-9 Pray they will not have a spirit of fear, but of power, love and sound mind. Realizing you have saved them and called them with a holy calling.

Numbers 6:24-26— Pray Blessings and Gratitude over our Pastors.

Matthew 6:33 Pray for our Pastor's Focus to Increase
